Glucoboy is a glucose meter for diabetics that can be connected to a Nintendo GameBoy.

Paul Wessell, whose son Luke was diagnosed with diabetes at age 3, is the creator of Glucoboy. Wessell noticed that Luke, when he was 7, clung to his GameBoy and hid his blood glucose meter.

So Wessell, whose background is in automation technology, founded Guidance Interactive Healthcare four years ago and invented Glucoboy for his son.

The device creates an incentive for kids to play with their hand-helds after scoring well on their blood tests. Designed for children with diabetes, Glucoboy is a blood glucose meter cartridge for the Nintendo GameBoy.
